Following the success of our online Alpha course in the first lockdown, back in March 2020, we are going to run 'The Prayer Course' online for this lockdown!

This will be on Tuesday evenings, at 7.45 for 8.00 pm, starting with an introductory first session on Tuesday 19th January (next week). Each session will be between 60 and 90 minutes long.

Prayer & relating to God is at the core of our Christian faith and the challenges of lockdown provide an ideal opportunity for us to press into this area more at this time.

Each session will include short video, the opportunity to discuss it's contents, and a chance to pray together in whatever way you feel comfortable at the end of the session. There is also a very good book by Pete Greig, which accompanies the course.
