

Parish of Nork with Burgh Heath Key Dates - January to April 2024

Below are some of the key dates for January to April 2024, including the Easter dates. Thank you very much to all who are involved in contributing to these different events. This is not an exhaustive list, but rather a list of all the dates we have to this point.

Worship in our churches

For these four months, we will continue to have some whole parish services at 10 am, usually on the fourth Sunday of every month (with some differences in March and for other special occasions). The whole parish services are listed a little later in this document.

On the other weeks of the month, services will continue at 9 am at St. Paul's and at 11 am at St. Mary's, with the option of Zoom for those who are unable to join us in the buildings.

Community Alive (family services at St. Paul's) will continue to be on the 2nd Sunday of every month at 9 am. Messy Church (family services at St. Mary's) will continue to be on the 3rd Sunday of every month at 11 am. Forest Church (in the St. Paul's Backlands) will resume on the 4th Sunday of April, at 3pm.

Our parish, 8 am, BCP communion service runs at St. Paul's on Tuesday mornings every week.

Messy Church (our Family Service based at St. Mary's), at 11 am on the 3rd Sunday of the month, with the exception of March where we will have a Messy Easter Celebration on Good Friday at 11 am instead.
