2. Remembering Loved Ones - Sunday 3rd November

On Sunday, 3rd November, it will be our 'Remembering Loved Ones' services at St. Paul's at 9 am and at St. Mary's at 11 am.

Last Sunday we had sheets out to write names of those who have died to be read out in the service and these lists will be available to be added to at the start of the services on Sunday.

3. Remembrance Sunday - Sunday 10th November

Sunday 10th November is Remembrance Sunday and we will have two services to mark this in our parish: 9 am more informal, Community Alive with an act of Remembrance at St. Paul's and our traditional Remembrance Service at St. Mary's at 10.45 (an earlier time than usual to enable 2 minutes silence at 11 am).

For those who wish to attend, there is also the Remembrance Parade at the War Memorial in Banstead at 10.30 am (Banstead High Street will be closed from this time). As Chair of the Banstead Five Churches Together, I will be participating in this service and David Packham will be leading the service at St. Mary's. I will be leading the service at St. Paul's before going on to Banstead.
